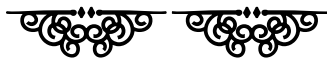
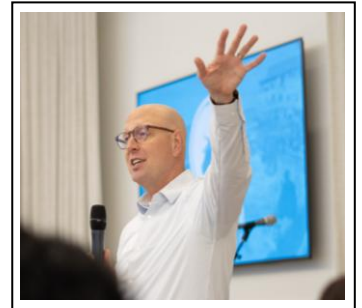
The March Quarters collected is on March 16th.

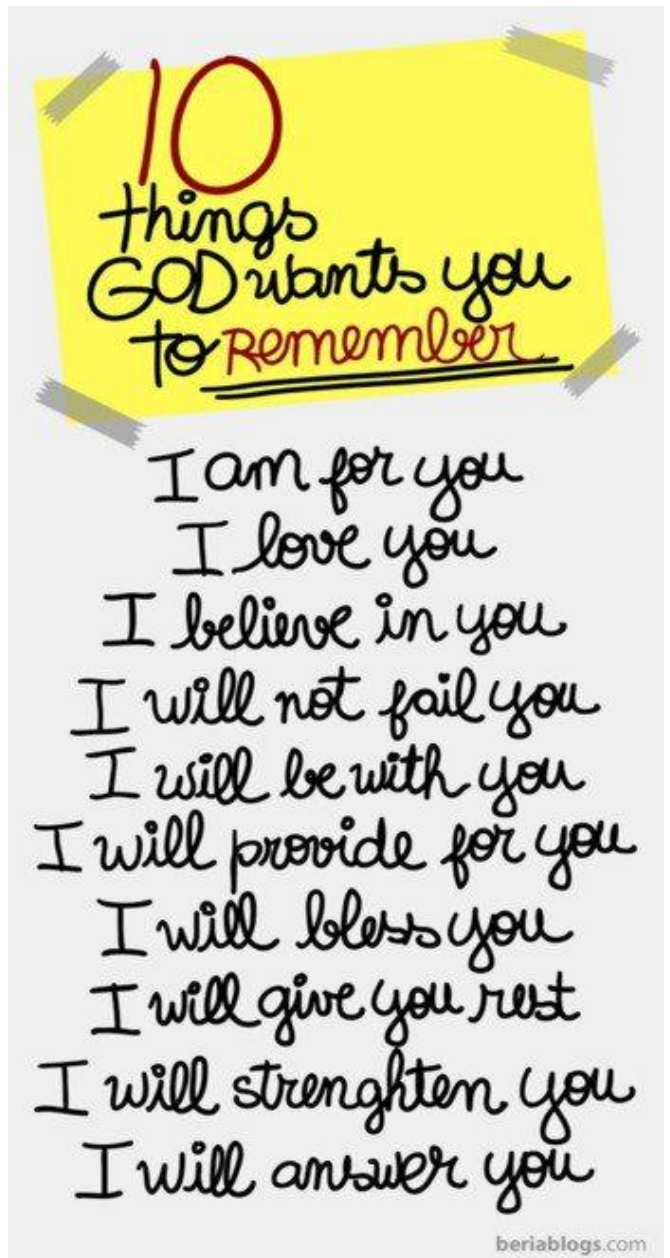
